**Selection Process for the Chief Minister's Fellowship Programme**

**I. Criteria for short listing (100 Points)**

1. The shortlisting of 50 applicants will be based on the following 5 criteria:
  - a. Essential Academic Qualification (30 Points)
  - b. Other Additional Qualification over and above Masters Degree (20 Points)
  - c. Experience (20 Points)
  - d. Research Publications (20 Points)
  - e. Research Projects (10 Points)
2. **Essential Academic Qualification** (30 Points) will be calculated as the product of Percent Marks at Masters Degree and 0.3 i.e.  $0.3 * \% \text{Marks}$
3. **Other Additional Qualification over and above Masters Degree** (20 Points)
  - a. Each additional qualification over and above Masters Degree will be given points as
    - i. Post Doctoral/Ph.D. – 10 Points
    - ii. M.Phil. – 5 Points
    - iii. Additional Masters Degree – 5 Points
    - iv. LLB – 3 Points
    - v. Post Graduate Diploma/Other additional qualification of minimum one year duration – 2 Points
  - b. The Maximum Points that can be scored in this criterion is 20.
4. **Experience** (20 Points)
  - a. Each year of experience will be allotted 4 Points.
  - b. The Maximum Points that can be scored in this criterion is 20.
5. **Research Publications** (20 Points)
  - a. Each paper/publication will be given points as
    - i. Paper published in Scopus/Web of Science indexed journal – 4 Points
    - ii. Paper published in Journals listed in UGC Care List – 3 Points
    - iii. Paper published in Journals with ISSN/ISBN – 2 Points
    - iv. Papers presented in International Conference – 3 Points
    - v. Papers presented in National Conference – 2 Points
    - vi. Papers presented in State/Regional Conference – 1 Point
  - b. The Maximum Points that can be scored in this criterion is 20.
6. **Research Projects** (10 Points)
  - a. Each project will be given points as
    - i. Major Research Project-Completed – 3 Points
    - ii. Major Research Project-Ongoing – 2 Points
    - iii. Minor Research Project-Completed – 2 Points
    - iv. Minor Research Project-Ongoing – 1 Point
  - b. The Maximum Points that can be scored in this criterion is 10.

Candidates should secure a minimum of 35 points in the above criteria to be eligible for shortlisting.

**II. Oral Interview (100 Points)**

**III. Criteria for selection of final candidates:**

50% weightage for points secured in Essential Academic Qualification, other Additional Qualification over an above Masters Degree, Experience, Research Publications and Research Projects and 50% weightage for personal assesment(viva/oral interview).
